A PhD student transferred from an MPhil candidature shall be subject to a study period of 36 months (part-time 54 months) for studying under the three-year programme and 48 months (part-time 72 months) for studying under the four-year programme. The student shall pay the composition fee for this said period calculated from the initial date of registration of the MPhil degree.

PhD to MPhil: The period of study of such a student for the MPhil degree shall be counted from the initial date of registration of the PhD candidature.
